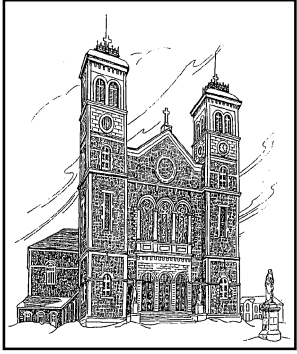

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER - MAY 14TH, 2017

Today's first reading from Acts telling us the story of the first deacons to be called to ministry reminds us that God's work needs to be shared among many ministries. Today we hear from Peter that the church is like a building with Christ as the 'cornerstone', and we, the 'people of God' as the 'living stones' that make up the church. It also follows from what we hear today, that love is the cement that binds these living stones together, and draws others to embrace our faith. Today the most intriguing of all spiritual questions is asked by Thomas: "How can we know the way?" All sincere searchers throughout the ages have asked this question, and today's readings give us some insight into it. Our first reading tells us that to be true disciples of Jesus, to follow the 'way', we are called to serve the needs of the poor and preach the Good News of Jesus. The second reading from Peter tells us that we are called to holiness - even though this 'way' may be 'rejected by mortals'. The Gospel passage today tells us that we are to live as intimates of Jesus - an intimacy that directs its love outwards in the service of others, and which finds, recognizes, and loves the Jesus who is both a dwelling place for us and finds a dwelling place in us. The same Jesus listens to our inner hearts, walks with us, is 'the way, the truth, and the life', who calls us and who brings us home to the place prepared for us.

THE CATECHETICAL OFFICE at the Basilica provides parents with the resources to form their children in faith and prepare them to celebrate the sacraments.
